HAZEL JANE PLANTE is a librarian, cat photographer, and writer. Her debut novel, *Little Blue Encyclopedia (for Vivian)* (Metonymy Press, 2019) won a Lambda Literary Award and was also a finalist for a Publishing Triangle Award and a BC and Yukon Book Prize. She releases music under the name lo-fi lioness and lives in Vancouver.

From the author of *Little Blue Encyclopedia* (for Vivian) comes the fictional memoir of a trans indie rock musician that reveals how the act of creation can heal trauma and even change the past.

Any Other City is a two-sided fictional memoir by Tracy St. Cyr, who helms the beloved indie rock band Static Saints. Side A is a snapshot of her life from 1993, when Tracy arrives in a labyrinthine city as a fledgling artist and unexpectedly falls in with a clutch of trans women, including the iconoclastic visual artist Sadie Tang.

Side B finds Tracy in 2019, now a semi-famous musician, back in the same strange city, healing from a traumatic event through songwriting, queer kinship, and sexual pleasure. While writing her memoir, Tracy perceives how the past reverberates into the present, how a body is a time machine, how there's power in refusing to dust the past with powdered sugar, and how seedlings begin to slowly grow in empty spaces after things have been broken open.

Motifs recur like musical phrases, and traces of what used to be there peek through, like a palimpsest. *Any Other City* is a novel about friendship and other forms of love, travelling in a body across decades, and transmuting trauma through art making and queer sex—a love letter to trans femmes and to art itself.


A new edition of two-time Lambda Literary Award-winner Casey Plett's acclaimed debut short story collection



CORINNA CHONG's first novel, *Belinda's Rings*, was published by NeWest Press in 2013, and her short fiction has appeared in magazines across Canada, including *Grain*, *Room*, and *Riddle Fence*. She won the 2021 CBC Short Story Prize for "Kids in Kindergarten." She lives in Kelowna, BC, where she is a professor of English and fine arts at Okanagan College.

Throughout *The Whole Animal*, flawed characters wrestle with the complexities of relationships with partners, parents, children, and friends as they struggle to find identity, belonging, and autonomy. Bodies are divided, often elusive, even grotesque. In "Porcelain Legs," a preteen fixes on the long, thick hair growing from her mother's eyelid. In "Wolf-Boy Saturday," a linguist grasps for connection with a young boy whose negligent upbringing has left him unable to speak. In "Butter Buns," a college student sees his mother in a new light when she takes up bodybuilding.

With strange juxtapositions, beguiling dark humour, and lurid imagery, *The Whole Animal* illuminates the everyday experiences of loneliness and loss, of self-alienation and self-discovery, that make us human.



White Riot: The 1907 Anti-Asian Riots in Vancouver explores the conditions leading up to and the impact of a demonstration and parade in Vancouver, Canada, organized by the Asiatic Exclusion League and the ensuing mob attack on the city's Chinese Canadian and Japanese Canadian communities. Emblematic of a systemically racist era, *White Riot* reveals the social and political environment of the time, when racialized communities were targeted through legislated as well as physical acts of exclusion and violence.

Based on *360 Riot Walk*, a 360-degree-video walking tour by artist and author Henry Tsang, *White Riot* offers an intersectional approach to this pivotal moment in the history of racialized communities and a cultural and social context for the current wave of anti-Asian sentiment. It features photographs of the riots colourized by Tsang. Essays by Tsang and others speak to the colonial times that preceded and followed the 1907 riots, as well as issues that Chinese and Japanese communities (and other racialized communities) in North America are facing today. *White Riot* poses the question: in the current ethos of anti-racism and decolonization, what does it take to reconcile our collective histories within the legacy of white supremacy?

Includes essays by the Asian Canadian Labour Alliance, Paul Englesberg, Melody Ma, Angela May and Nicole Yakashiro, Jeffery R. Masuda, Aaron Franks, Audrey Kobayashi and Trevor Wideman, and Andy Yan, with an introduction by Patricia E. Roy.



HENRY TSANG is an artist who explores the spatial politics of history, language, community, food, and cultural translation in relationship to place. His artworks take the form of gallery exhibitions, 360-degree-video walking tours, curated dinners, and public art. Henry teaches at Emily Carr University of Art + Design in Vancouver.

A. LIGHT ZACHARY is a writer, editor, and artist who was recently awarded fellowships for their poetry by the Lambda Literary Foundation and the Banff Centre for the Arts. Their previous publications include the novella *The End, by Anna* (Metatron, 2016). *More Sure* is their first book of poems. They live in Toronto.

A book of poems and augmentations recording instances of love, self-realization, and recovery in non-binary, queer, and autistic lives

In their stunning debut collection, A. Light Zachary draws power from a vision of life—especially queer and neurodivergent life—as a journey of continuous self-realization. These poems record the experience of locating oneself over and over again, within gender, language, family, labour, sexuality, fear, and love.

Reaching back to claim queer space in the oldest Western canon, Zachary interrupts famous quotations from ancient Greek and Roman thinkers, asking what advice Juvenal or Seneca might have handed down to non-binary citizens. Elsewhere, in concise and fluid verses that draw from punk rock and quantum physics, they ground the work firmly in the present. Come: invade with the alien. Evade with the coyote. These poems propose a certain supremacy; in these unending journeys of discovery and alienation, "we become more sure of who we are than you."

Building on the work of her game-changing book, *Care Work: Dreaming Disability Justice*, Piepzna-Samarasinha writes about disability justice at the end of the world, documenting the many ways disabled people kept and are keeping each other—and the rest of the world—alive during Trump, fascism, and the COVID-19 pandemic. Other subjects include crip interdependence, care and mutual aid in real life, disabled community building, and disabled art practice as survival and joy.

She navigates and writes across the many blank spaces to form a story of discovery and humanity, examining themes of grief, pain, mental illness, trauma, creative expression, identity, and deep, unending love inside just one of the thousands of deaths that have occurred as a result of the opioid crisis.

With poignant honesty and a heart laid bare, *Holden After and Before* is a beautiful and moving elegy to a son lost to overdose.



In this beautifully illustrated book, a determined young Anishnaabe girl in search of adventure goes on a journey into a forest located on her traditional territory. She is joined by a chorus of her ancestors in red dresses, who tell her they remember what it was like to be carefree and wild too. Soon, though, the girl is challenged by a monster named Hate, who envelops her in a cloud of darkness. She climbs a mountain to evade the monster, and, with the help of her matriarchs and the power of Thunderbird, the monster is held at bay. Together the girl and her ancestors beat their drums in song and support, giving the girl the confidence she needs to become a changemaker in the future, capable of fending off any monster in her way.

Together We Drum, Our Hearts Beat as One is a moving and powerful book about Indigenous resistance and ancestral connection.

Tsqelmucwílc

The Kamloops Indian Residential School— Resistance and a Reckoning

CELIA HAIG-BROWN, RANDY FRED, AND GARRY GOTTFRIEDSON

"Tsquelmucwilc" (pronounced cha-CAL-mux-weel) is a Secwépemc phrase loosely translated as "We return to being human again." *Tsqelmucwilc* is the story of those who survived the Kamloops Indian Residential School, based on the 1988 book *Resistance and Renewal*, a groundbreaking history of the school and the first book on residential schools ever published in Canada. *Tsqelmucwilc* includes the original text as well as new material by the original book's author, Celia Haig-Brown; essays by Secwépemc poet and KIRS survivor Garry Gottfriedson and Nuu-Chah-Nulth Elder and residential school survivor Randy Fred; and first-hand reminiscences by other survivors of KIRS, as well as their children, on their experience and the impact of their trauma throughout their lives.

Read both within and outside the context of the grim 2021 discoveries, *Tsqelmucwilc* is a tragic story in the history of Indigenous Peoples of the indignities suffered at the hands of their colonizers, but it is equally a remarkable tale of Indigenous survival, resilience, and courage.


Postcards from Congo


The Stories Behind the Province's Most Sensational Murder and Missing Person Cases

In her BC bestseller *Cold Case Vancouver*, crime historian and reporter Eve Lazarus used investigative skills to shine a light on the city's most baffing unsolved murders. In *Cold Case BC*, Lazarus casts her gaze more widely on long forgotten and unsolved murder and missing person cases throughout British Columbia. These include teenager Molly Justice, who was murdered on the outskirts of Victoria after taking the bus home from work, and a follow-up to the tragic Babes in the Woods story of two children found murdered in Stanley Park in 1953, whose names were finally revealed in a story broken by Lazarus herself in 2022.

Interviews with law enforcement, forensic experts, and family and friends of the victims add new life to these historical cases, some of which date back to World War II. The book also includes some cases that have been solved, revealing the painstaking investigative work and new forensic technology that ultimately brought about closure for victims' families.

Meticulously researched, *Cold Case BC* is a fascinating true crime book that reveals startling details about the province's criminal past.


LARISSA LAI

Lambda Literary Award–winner Larissa Lai (*The Tiger Flu*) returns with a sprawling historical novel about war, colonialism, and queer experience during Japan's occupation of Hong Kong during World War II. On the eve of the return of the British Crown Colony of Hong Kong to China in 1997, young Ophelia asks her peculiar great-aunt Violet about the Japanese occupation of Hong Kong during World War II and the disappearance of her uncle Raymond, and whether her grandmother, Emily, was a murderer.

Emily's marriage to her father's mortal enemy causes a stir among three very different Hong Kong Chinese families. But the class and race pettiness of the scandal around Emily's marriage is violently disrupted by the Japanese Imperial Army's invasion of Hong Kong on Christmas Day, 1941, which plunges the colony into a landscape of violence none of its inhabitants escape from unscathed, least of all Emily. When her sister's situation becomes dire, Violet, along with a crew of unlikely cosmopolitans, determines to rescue Emily from the wrath of the person she thought loved her the most, her husband, Tak-Wing.

With great heart, *The Lost Century* explores the intersections of Asian relations, queer Asian history, underground resistance, the violence of war, and the rise of modern China.

On the run from the allpowerful Madjideye with her lover, Bèl, a descendant of the Warrior Nation, they seek to share what the world has forgotten: stories. In Pasakamate, both Shkitagen, the firekeeper of his generation, and his life's heart, Nitàwesì, whose hands mend bones and cure sickness, attempt to find a home where they can raise children in peace, without fear of slavers or rising waters. In Zhōng yang, Riordan born without legs, wheels around just fine, leading xir gang of misfits in hopes of surviving until the next meal. However, Elite Enforcer H-09761 (Yun Seo, abducted as a child, then tortured and brainwashed into servitude) is determined to arrest Riordan for theft of resources and will stop at nothing to bring xir to the Madjideye. In a ruined world, six people collide, discovering family and foe, navigating friendship and love, and reclaiming the sacredness of the gifts they carry.

With themes of resistance, of ceremony as the conduit between realms, and of transcending gender, *Màgòdiz* is a powerful and visionary reclamation that Two-Spirit people always have and always will be vital to the cultural and spiritual legacy of their communities.


Queer Little Nightmares


In the Key of Dale
